Pupil Outcomes

Dodford First School is a much smaller than an average sized primary school with a maximum of 75 pupils (15 pupils per year group). This results in the attainment data being changeable from one year to the next, depending on the cohort make up – numbers of boys, girls, SEND pupils and disadvantaged pupils. One pupil is equivalent to 6.7%, so again comparing to national data, it may appear that % wise we are significantly different, whereas this could be equivalent to one or two pupils.

We track our children rigorously throughout their learning journey with us at Dodford, looking at their starting points and then tracking their progress over time before they leave us at the end of Year 4. We have ambitious targets for all pupils, hopefully enabling them to achieve their full potential with us.

The table below shows the attainment picture at Dodford over the past three years.
