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## **After School Clubs**

Art, Multi sports and Football club all start next week and can be paid for via Parent Pay or by directly contacting the coaches. Children need a separate kit brought into school if they are taking part in a sports club.

#### **PE Days**

Wrens—do not need a PE kit this half term, they will have PE lessons Tuesdays and Fridays.

Robins—Thursdays and Fridays

Owls—Tuesdays and Fridays

Children should leave their PE kits in school at all times and they will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed, unless they get particularly dirty during a session.

#### **Uniform reminders**

Please can we kindly remind you that, PE kits are either navy blue or burgundy as listed in our uniform list, pumps need to be kept in school. Trainers can be kept in school or brought in on PE days.

No long hair loose, hair should not be dyed and longer hair tied up on PE days. No nail varnish or false nails and jewellery is limited to a watch and stud earrings (which should preferably be taken out on PE days and left at home.

All children should have a school coat with them every day—the weather has shown this week how unpredictable it can be!

#### Lunches

School dinners must be booked in advance, we are aware that the updates over the summer caused some errors this week, hopefully these are all now sorted. Any queries or changes in orders should go directly to the caterers st.peters@classcatering.co.uk. Lunch boxes from home should be 'healthy' and a small, snack size sugary snack can be included but please no giant cookies or full size chocolate bars and no nut items due to allergies, thank you.

#### **Outdoor Days**

**Wrens** class (reception) should come to school in outdoor clothes every Monday for their Muddy Monday session. For this half term only, can children in **Robins** class come to school in outdoor clothes each Friday. Remember these clothes should be old and long sleeves. Aand full length trousers. All children need wellies for planned outdoor activities, which change on a weekly basis.

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### Year 3 and 4 (Owls Class)

Please can we remind you that children in Owls need to bring in a snack for break time as the fruit delivered to school is for the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. The snack must be healthy, such as fruit or a grain bar (no nut products).
