Clematis, Honeysuckle, Hyacinth – all have beautiful smells for a sensory garden

Cosmos seeds – these can be planted and give off a beautiful chocolate smell.

Lavender - attracts beneficial pollinators to its fragrant blooms. Adding lavender to your garden will attract butterflies, bees, and other helpful insects.

Ornamental grasses Cymbopogon citratus (lemon grass) – provides a citrus scent

Herbs ready to grow in the garden (not seeds).

Provide an abundance of smells, to entice the senses.

Mint – Mentha spicata. ...

Fennel – Foeniculum vulgare. ...


French tarragon – Artemisia dracunculus. ...
