## **Report on Sports Premium**

### **Introduction – Sports Premium Funding..what is it?**

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum to improve the provision of Physical Education and School Sport for all Primary aged children.

This funding, provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport will be allocated to all schools with Primary aged children and began back in 2013-2014.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and School Sport. Possible uses for the funding might include:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE
- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new clubs
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games
- Purchasing quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- Providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- Attending sporting tournaments
- Paying for new resources and equipment for lessons and on the school playground

From September 2013, schools have been held to account over how they spend their additional, ring-fenced funding.

Schools will be required to include details of their provision of PE and sport on their website, alongside details of their broader curriculum, so that parents can compare sports provision between schools, both within and beyond the school day.
