Our library has seen great improvements recently. Each class visits the library every fortnight and can borrow a book to take home.

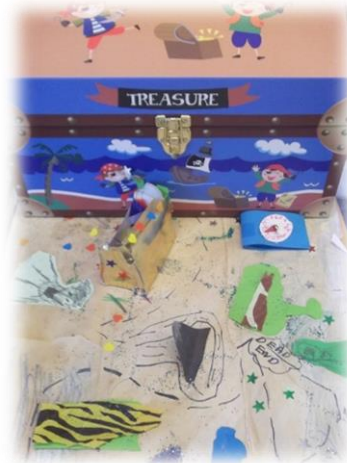


Dodford Literacy Spine
