<p>Our summer topic is called WISH YOU WERE HERE! It's all about exploring weather, seasons and climate in the UK. This week we are going to start exploring UK weather. Here is your topic task for this week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think about the different kinds of weather we get in the UK e.g. sunny, rainy, cloudy, windy. Get an adult to help you generate a word bank of weather words. • Design a simple way of recording the weather for each day of this week.
