You could illustrate each page too! • Learn to read five phase 4 irregular words <i>said, have, like, so, do</i>. • Create a quick noughts and crosses game with the words <i>clown, club, clam, clip, cliff, clap, click, cling, clan</i> for your child to play with you or a sibling. Before drawing the nought or cross in the chosen spot, read the word. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Position - Play hide and seek and explain where you are when found or where you find someone. "You've found me <u>under</u> the table." "I have found you <u>behind</u> the curtain." • Time - Include the time in your daily diary entry. Example: At 9 o'clock I started the Joe Wicks workout. <p>Summer 1 Topic: Fairies and Frogs: Exploring stories through the arts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sit in your favourite spot at home and either retell a familiar story or tell your own story to a loved one. If you have access, you may like to video call someone special and tell them the story too! • Research the frog life cycle. 	<p><u>V.E. DAY</u> Why not design your own V.E. Day medal or bunting? Create a party hat for V.E. Day, plan your own 'house/drive party' including food, and design a place mat for your party. Be creative!</p> <p><u>CAPTAIN / COLONEL TOM</u> Why not have a look at Picture News attached to Mrs Parkes' newsletter this week? There are lots of ideas PSHE and writing activities.</p> <p><u>MUSIC</u> Create your own song and sing it to someone.</p> <p><u>PE</u> Write different animals on slips of paper. Take turns to turn a slip of paper over and move like that animal. Example: you pick a slip of paper with frog written on it. Think how a frog moves and move that way. Extension: don't tell your partner what is written on the slip of paper, they have to watch you move and then guess!
