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#### Polite Reminder—Pe Kit

PE kits will be coming home to be washed. Can you please check that everything is labelled and in your child's bag on return to school after the holiday. Staff have commented that there is a lot of lost PE time at the start of lessons trying to find PE kit items for the children as they are missing or not labelled. We are also still finding children that do not have their indoor and outdoor winter PE kit in school. Your help will be much appreciated, thank you.

### **Polite Request**

Please can I ask for a little patience in the morning. The school day officially begins at 8.50am, but we have made the decision that the children can come into school from 8.40am as we know this helps working parents and the road congestion outside of school. ### **Measles and MMR Jabs**

NHS Herefordshire and Worcestershire and Public Health are holding pop-up MMR vaccination clinics in these areas. If your child hasn't had the MMR vaccination just turn up. You can ask for an MMR vaccine which does not contain pork ingredients if you prefer. Not sure if you or your child have, had it? Just check your red NHS book or ask at your local GP.

The clinics are being hosted in libraries on the following dates:
